Miniature Horse Classes RIHS Qualifier

These classes are affiliated to the British Miniature Horse Society (BMHS), all classes will be run under their rules. Only registered horses owned by a BMHS member may enter. Owners, handlers and exhibitors must be current members of the British Miniature Horse Society and have paid the appropriate BMHS 2021 Showing Levy.

These classes are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, **the first and second horse in each class will qualify**, or if already qualified the next highest placed unqualified horse down to fifth place will qualify.

Horses must be in possession of a 2021 measuring certificate (as per BMHS Showing Declaration form) or if not, must be measured for any qualification to remain valid.

Height limits for all classes are as follows:-

In all cases, whips/canes must not exceed 30" in length.

Objections to be made in writing to the show secretary, together with a deposit of £40, within one hour of the disputed event. If the objection is upheld the deposit will be forfeited.

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.

The most recent updates to the list are the addition of SNELL E2016 and EN1384 (2017); the newest version of the SNELL Standard could have begun to appear in 2017 and is accepted to the list; the newest version of the EN1384 Standard will begin to appear during 2018 and is also accepted to the list. Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull/riding hats.

If for any reason the show has to be cancelled; only half the entry fee will be refunded. In no other case will any entry fee be refunded.

In all M & M classes, ridden and in hand, ponies must be shown as recommended by their breed society rules, and are restricted to the heights laid down by their appropriate breed societies.

Summer Qualifiers: Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern 3rd – 5th August 2021.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/SUPREME PRODUCTS M&M WHP RIHS: Owner's must be Qualifying or life members to enter the qualifying class.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

British Show Pony Society classes:

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ('B.S.P.S.'), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to constitution and Rules of this society including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of this society. In all classes affiliated to the BSPS, the BSPS Rules take precedence.

UK Ponies & Horses classes:- This show is affiliated to UK Ponies & Horses. 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed ponies in Classes 17 to 20 will qualify for the UKPH Summer Classic, to take place on Sunday 15th & Monday 16th August 2021 at Onley Grounds Equestrian Centre, Warwickshire. Competitors are not required to become members to compete at the Summer Classic. Qualifying cards are NO longer given out in the ring, however results will be verified by the office.
