NPS AREA 13 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 **LIABILITY** Neither the organisers of the event, nor the NPS nor any agent employee or riders accept liability for any loss damage injury or illness to ponies owners riders spectators or property caused by negligence breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The organisers will expect all exhibitors to have third party insurance for their animals
- 2 The judge's decision is final. The committee reserve the right to substitute judges in case of unavailability. Please call the show secretary should you wish to check any judge changes.
- 3 The organisers may divide or amalgamate classes according to entries, and reserve the right to refuse entry
- 4 No spurs allowed. Whips and canes must not exceed an overall length of 30 inches and must be of plain leather covered. Please make sure you are certain of each individual society rules.
- 5 Mountain and Moorland ponies must be registered in their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Please give reg. No's on entry form as you entry will be returned if the form is not complete
- 6 All stallions and colts 2 years old or over must be in possession of a current stallion licence unless otherwise governed by their official breed society. In All NPS classes, All stallions must display a stallion bridle marker.
- 7 Inevitably some exhibitors classes will clash whilst stewards will try to accommodate you **NO CLASS WILL BE HELD UP FOR A SINGLE COMPETITOR**
- 8 The organisers will expect all exhibitors to have read these rules and to abide by them. Should a complaint be made, it must be accompanied by the name and address of the complainant (in writing) together with the sum of £25-00. This is non refundable if the complaint is upheld by the committee
- 9 All dogs must be kept on leads.

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2020.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2019/2020 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2020 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. The owner's valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third).

NPS / Kilmannan Stud M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M In Hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification Card. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the **2020** NPS Summer Championship Show.

NPS / Standinghat Stud & Show Team M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M In Hand section. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the **2020** NPS Summer Championship Show.

P(UK) SPRING CLASSIC 2020

1st 2nd and 3rd placed horses/ponies will qualify for the Spring Classic 2019. No membership required.

B.S.P.S. QUALIFICATION

RESTRICTED QUALIFICATION CARDS TO BE PRESENTED IN THE RING TO PONIES THAT QUALIFY FOR THE RESTRICTED CLASSES, THESE CARDS TO BE SENT IN WITH ENTRIES FOR THE WINTER CHAMPIONSHIPS. (Please see rules regarding Restricted qualification/eligibility). 1st – 8th at RIHS or HOYS in 2018, 2019 and 2020.

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize-winners in the Novice Classes will qualify and in MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners will qualify. In the Open Classes the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify, and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CLASSES the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband). Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners will qualify in the Novice classes and in the mixed height novice classes the 1st - 4th prizewinners will qualify. In the open classes the three highest placed Restricted animals will qualify and in the mixed height Open classes the 4 highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. (Riders on Restricted animals must wear an armband).

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.

Riders to be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride. For Shows held on or before 31st December, 2019 - "All Rules as per the 2019 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook, except for any new or amended rules as included in this Schedule. The following Classes are B.S.P.S. qualifiers for the 2019 B.S.P.S. Winter Championships Show. RULES FOR RESTRICTED QUALIFICATION IN THE OPEN NURSERY STAKES & OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY/INTERMEDIATE W.H. CLASSES:- Restricted Open Nursery Stakes- Animals eligible for the Restricted Nursery Stakes Class must NOT have been placed 1st – 8th at RIHS or HOYS in 2018, 2019 and 2020. Restricted Open Working Hunter Pony/Intermediate W.H.- Animals eligible for the Restricted W.H.P. or Restricted Int. W.H. must NOT have been placed 1st – 8th at RIHS or HOYS in 2018, 2019 and 2020..

RULES FOR RESTRICTED QUALIFICATION IN THE HERITAGE RIDDEN CLASSES:-

Animals eligible for the Restricted Heritage Ridden Classes must NOT have been placed 1st – 8th at RIHS or HOYS in 2018, 2019 and 2020. (except Pretty Polly), or H.O.Y.S., or Olympia in the Heritage M&M Ridden Classes in the PREVIOUS or CURRENT year.

RULES FOR RESTRICTED QUALIFICATION IN THE HERITAGE W.H.P. CLASSES:-

Animals eligible for the Restricted Heritage W.H.P. Classes must NOT have been placed 1st – 8th at RIHS or HOYS in 2018, 2019 and 2020. .
